WEEKLY UPDATE:

- **Grand Opening of Zaxby's:** The new Zaxby's restaurant at Exit 54 opened this Monday. The owners report that business during the first week was good.
- **Planning Commission:** The Planning Commission met this week and approved a request to annex a portion of Tallwood, name the road entering Clinton Corporate Park III Robert M. Vance Blvd, and to name the road entering the I26 Commerce Park "Technology Way".
- **MASC Training:** City staff, council members, and members of the various boards and commissions joined their counterparts from Laurens County, the City of Laurens, and the Town of Gray Court for the annual mandatory Planning Commission training held in Laurens at the Ridge Center.
- **PMPA Meeting:** The monthly PMPA Meeting was held this week. Attendees received information regarding Catawba operations, budget adjustments, and planned refueling outages for 2016 and 2017, and a discussion of solar use was held.
- **Dempsey's Fire:** A fire in a storage room at Dempsey's this week resulted in the restaurant closing temporarily while repairs are made.
- **ZIKA Response:** The Laurens County Emergency Planning Committee met this week to review plans regarding how communities are dealing with the threat of Zika. The city continues to treat for mosquitos and monitor private pools to ensure that mosquito breeding opportunities are limited.
