WEEKLY UPDATE:

- **SEDC Award:** City of Clinton Economic Development Manager Marvin Moss was awarded a lifetime honorary membership in the Southern Economic Development Council in recognition of his years of contributions to local economic development.
- **Laurens Leadership Council:** This grassroots organization continues to meet to support the need for long term strategic planning in our community.
- **National Night Out:** A good turnout made the city's second annual National Night Out a success. The event was held in Oak Street Park.
- **Tallwood Homes:** A public meeting was held at Tallwood Homes to discuss plans for the future sale of the property and the remodeling of the individual apartments.
- **New Business:** Magnolia Bloom Clothier opened in downtown Clinton on Musgrove Street.
- **Main Street:** City Council authorized the city to proceed with applying for admission into the National Main Street Program.
- **Reimbursement Resolution:** The City Council authorized a reimbursement resolution which will begin the project to replace water and sewer lines underneath South Broad Street.
- **Museum Commission Dissolution:** The Museum Commission Dissolution was tabled in order to allow for a review of FOIA responses from the museum and the review of alleged inconsistencies in the museum's record keeping.
