## **Notice of Change to the City of Clinton Sanitation Ordinance**

Clinton City Council passed an addition to the City Sanitation Ordinance at their meeting Monday March 4, 2024 regarding excessive waste placed on the streets to be picked up by the Sanitation Department.

The Change reads as follows:

### **SECTION 66-26**

#### **Sec.66-26 – Excessive Waste Generation**

It shall be mandatory that every landlord, contractor or resident generating waste greater than normal shall be required to schedule an excessive waste pick-up with the Streets and Sanitation Department. Excessive Waste Generation is any residential waste greater than 3 cubic yards measured on a load count basis; two clam truck scoops = 3 cubic yards. Scheduling of these pick-ups will require a 24 hour Notice to the Streets and Sanitation Division to prevent this excessive waste from spilling into the roadways or public rights of way and creating a negative appearance of these materials being placed on the curbside.

Excessive wastes pick-ups shall be required for the items listed below:

- Building Materials generated by residents, tenants, landlords or property owners
- Large household goods, furniture and carpets including but not limited to, mattresses, box springs, couches, tables, chairs and, metal goods.
- Any materials generated from rental property cleanouts or evictions initiated by the property owner or their agent.

Excessive waste greater than 3 cubic yards shall receive the appropriate fee based on volume as follows in this schedule

3 Cubic Yards (2 Scoops)	\$0.00
6 Cubic Yards (4 Scoops)	\$30.00
9 Cubic Yards (6 Scoops)	\$55.00
12 Cubic Yards (8 Scoops)	\$75.00
Non Scheduled Pick up Fee	\$50.00
