



## City of Clinton Department of Public Works Sanitation Services

**The following items can be placed on the curb for disposal by city sanitation crews.**

Sanitation Type	Sanitation Description	Collection Information
Household Garbage	Household garbage – all items shall fit in the City approved green roll carts. If it is not in the roll cart, and the lid doesn't close, <i>it will not be collected by the garbage truck</i> on your collection day.	Roll your cart to the curb by midnight day before your designated collection day. Cart needs to be Removed No Later Than 9 PM on collection day. Handle/Wheels Need to face the residence. Can Needs to be three feet from other objects such as: (Vehicles, Mailboxes, Utility Poles, Other Cans, Etc.) <i>Holiday Collection and other changes will be printed in the Chronicle, posted on the city webpage, and posted on the city's Facebook page.</i>
Limbs	Residential limbs and brush - <i>limbs and brush cleared by a commercial landscaping service must be removed by the commercial landscaper.</i>	<i>Do not mix your limbs with other items and cut them to no larger than 6" diameter and 4' length.</i> Place limbs in a separate pile by themselves prior to 6:00 a.m. of your garbage cart collection day. They will be picked up by 5:00 p.m. the following day.
Grass and Leaves	Grass clippings and leaves	<i>Do not bag grass and leaves, and do not mix grass and leaves with other items such as limbs and brush or man made items.</i> Place them in a pile prior 6:00 a.m. of your garbage cart collection day. They will be picked up by 5:00 p.m. the following day.
Man Made Items	Items such as furniture, old clothing, toys, cardboard boxes, and paint* that will not fit in the garbage cart.	Place man made materials in a separate pile prior to 6:00 a.m. of your garbage cart collection day. They will be picked up by 5:00 p.m. the following day. <i>*Please fill paint cans with sand or other absorbent materials such as kitty litter, replace the lids, and place them on the curb or in your green roll cart for pickup.</i>
Construction Debris	Items used in building a house such as roofing material, siding, bricks, plywood, lumber, carpet, and plumbing supplies	Construction Materials Generated by a Contractor shall be disposed of by the contractor and not to be put out at the curb. If Construction Debris is generated by a resident it can be collected with a charge to your utility bill. <i>Call the Department of Public Works at 833-7520 for more information or to schedule a pick up.</i>
Electronics	Computers, monitors, printers, faxes, televisions, telephones, cable boxes, power tools, cameras, DVD/VCR players, cables/	New regulations from the South Carolina DHEC prevents the disposal of electronics that have been disassembled. <i>To prevent this call the Department of Public Works at 833-7520 to schedule a pick up.</i>
Appliances	Freezers, stoves, refrigerators, microwaves.	Remove the doors, and place upside down so children can not get trapped inside, place on the curb and <i>call the Department of Public Works at 833-7520 to schedule a pick up.</i>

**WE DO NOT COLLECT – CAR BATTERIES, MOTOR OIL, TREATED WOOD, PESTICIDES/HERBICIDES, OR TRACTOR SIZED TIRES.**  
Please make sure you place your curbside refuse to be collected where it is safely accessible and convenient for removal and disposal by collection vehicles - placing items near or under a utility pole or parking a car in front of your items will result in the refuse not being collected.
