ANNEX PROPERTY
656-00-00-001 | Mayor McLean stated that the first item on the agenda is the second reading of an Ordinance of the City of Clinton for the annexation of contiguous real property located on the North West Corner of the Intersection SC 72 and West Corporate Center Drive into the corporate limits of the City of Clinton; Laurens Tax Map Number 656-00-00-001. Motion was made by Councilmember Neal to approve the second reading of an Ordinance annexing property Laurens County Tax Map Number 656-00-00-001 and seconded by Councilmember Jenkins. The vote was unanimous. |

Motion was made by Councilmember Kuykendall to approve the second reading of an Ordinance annexing property Laurens County Tax Map Number 656-00-00-032 and seconded by Councilmember Cook. The vote was unanimous. |

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor McLean stated that the Council meetings have become long and Council has the right to say what they wish but if Council has issues in their Wards such as a pot hole or a damaged tree then the Council meeting is not the appropriate place to discuss the matter. Mayor McLean stated that he feels the issue should go to the City Manager first and then if Council does not receive any response then discuss the issue at the Council meeting. Mr. Cannon, City Manager stated that City staff will be upgrading the City's social media and website. Mr. Cannon stated that the purpose of this upgrade is to allow citizens easy access to identify the area and be able to relay the problem to City staff. Mr. Cannon thanked Council for moving forward with the QuikTrip annexation. Mayor McLean asked about the water basin problem on South Broad Street and Mr. Cannon stated that the City is working on the issue. Mr. Cannon stated that the problem with South Broad is the lack of coordination between the SCDOT, the contractor and the City of Clinton. Mayor McLean stated that the manholes are OK but the water basins are not. Mayor McLean asked if the City has moved forward with placing the utilities underground on South Broad. Mr. Cannon stated that he would find the Pole Attachment Agreements and look into the matter.
