A special called meeting was held at the M.S. Bailey Center at 7:30 AM with Mayor Bob McLean presiding with Councilmembers Cook, Walsh, Neal, Kuykendall, and Roth. The City Manager and the City Attorney were present. No news media was present. Notice was emailed to all local news media on May 14, 2019.

INVOCATION The invocation was given by Mayor Bob McLean.

PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE Mayor Mclean asked Council and the audience to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PAVING BID
COPELAND ST
GARY ST
THORNWELL ST**

Mayor McLean stated that the first item on the agenda is the approval of a bid to pave sections of Gary Street, Copeland Street, and Thornwell Street from Panagakos Asphalt Paving for a cost of \$93,166.00. Mayor Mclean recognized Mr. Meadors, Public Works Director. Mr. Meadors stated that in July 2018 the Laurens County Transportation Committee awarded the City \$100,000 to pave Copeland Street and Gary Street. Mr. Meadors stated that the first block of Copeland Street has been paved and these funds would cover the second block of Copeland Street. Mr. Meadors stated that the City has also added Thornwell Street to the project. Mr. Meadors stated that the City would have to receive permission from the Laurens County Transportation Committee to use some of the funds for Thornwell Street but if permission is not granted the City has funds in the current budget to pave Thornwell Street. Motion was made by Councilmember Neal to approve the bid from Panagakos Asphalt Paving to pave portions of Copeland Street, Gary Street, and Thornwell Street for a cost not to exceed \$93,166 and seconded by Councilmember Kuykendall. The vote was unanimous.

**SEWER REHAB BID
GARY ST
THORNWELL ST**

Mayor Mclean stated that the next item on the agenda is approval of a bid for sewer rehabilitation for Gary Street and Thornwell Street from Inland Pipe Rehabilitation for a cost of \$88,400. Mr. Meadors stated in 2018 the City received a CDBG grant to rehab Clinton Mill's Sewer System. Mr. Meadors stated that the previous Public Works Director also applied for a RIA Grant for various Sewer System repairs in other areas of the City but the City did not receive the grant. Mr. Meadors stated that the City needs to make repairs to the Sewer System on Gary Street before using the Laurens County Transportation Funds to pave Gary Street. Mr. Meadors stated that the City solicited bids for the Sewer System repairs to portions of Gary Street and Thornwell Street and received a low bid of \$88,400 from Inland Pipe Rehabilitation.

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Councilmember Walsh stated that the RIA Grand was not granted but the CDBG was and Mr. Meadors stated yes. Councilmember Kuykendall asked if the City would be able to make the Sewer System repairs in time to get the paving done and Mr. Meadors stated yes. Councilmember Roth asked if there is a time limit on the funds from Laurens County and Mr. Meadors stated June 30, 2019. Mr. Meadors stated that some of the repairs can be done without digging up the road which would save some time. Councilmember Walsh stated that citizens always wonder why the City does projects in sections. Mr. Meadors stated that the City has to work within the budget and since the City did not receive the RIA Grant then the City does not have the funds to repair and pave all of Gary Street at one time. Mayor Mclean stated that four years ago the City did not receive any funds from the Laurens County Transportation Committee but due to having a representative from Clinton on the board has helped the City receive funds for paving. Motion was made by Councilmember Kuykendall to approve the bid from Inland Pipe Rehabilitation for Sewer System repairs on Gary Street and Thornwell Street for a cost not to exceed \$88,400 and seconded by Councilmember Neal. The vote was unanimous.

ADJOURN

With there being no further business before Council motion was made by Councilmember Kuykendall to adjourn and seconded by Councilmember Neal. The vote was unanimous.
