

SEPTEMBER 18, 2019

A special called meeting was held at the M.S. Bailey Center with Mayor Bob McLean presiding with Councilmembers Cook, Jenkins, Kuykendall, Neal, Roth, and Walsh. The City Manager and the City Attorney were also present. Local news media present was Monty Dutton from GoClinton.com. Notice was emailed to all local news media on Tuesday, September 17, 2019.

- INVOCATION** The invocation was given by Councilmember Kuykendall.
- PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE** Mayor McLean asked Council and the audience to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.
- EXECUTIVE SESSION** Motion was made by Councilmember Cook to go into executive session and discuss one matter relating to the appointment of a person to a public body or regulated by a public body and return to open session on the call of the chair and seconded by Councilmember Neal. The vote was unanimous.
- OPEN SESSION** Mayor McLean declared Council back in open session. Mayor McLean stated that one matter relating to the appointment of a person to a public body or regulated by a public body was discussed and no action was taken.
- APPOINTMENT
SALES TAX
COMMISSION** Mayor McLean stated that the next item on the agenda is the nomination and appointment of a representative to the Sales Tax Commission for the Local Option Capital Improvement Tax. Mayor McLean stated that the City has been tasked to appoint one person to serve on the six member committee. Mayor McLean stated that this committee would select the projects, prioritize the projects, and place the projects on the upcoming ballots for citizens to vote on. Mayor McLean stated that Clinton's selection along with the City of Laurens' selection would select the sixth member of the committee. Mayor McLean stated that the nominee should be knowledgeable in capital projects as well as the needs in Clinton and Laurens County. Mayor McLean stated that the nominee should reside within the corporate limits of Clinton. Mayor McLean stated that this would be a very involved committee and the nominee should be ready to serve. Motion was made by Councilmember Walsh to nominate Mr. Walter Hughes III to the Sales Tax Commission and seconded by Councilmember Jenkins. The vote was unanimous.
- COUNCILMEMBER
REPORT** Councilmember Jenkins asked if Mr. Hughes would meet with Council to discuss our Capital Improvements Projects. Mayor McLean stated that he could but is not required to do so. Councilmember Jenkins asked if Council should come up with a list and Mayor McLean agreed.

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Mayor Mclean stated that Council could give a Capital Improve Projects list to Mr. Cannon, City Manager, or Council could hold a workshop to discuss the needs of Clinton.
