

APRIL 24, 2019

A special called meeting was held at the M.S. Bailey Center at 6:00 PM with Mayor Bob McLean presiding with Councilmembers Cook, Jenkins, Kuykendall, Neal, Roth, and Walsh. The City Manager and the City Attorney were present. Notice was emailed to all local news media on April 18, 2019.

- INVOCATION** The invocation was given by Mayor Bob Mclean.
- PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE** Mayor Mclean asked Council and the audience to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.
- EXECUTIVE SESSION** Motion was made by Councilmember Kuykendall to enter into an executive session to discuss one contractual matter relating to the Martha Dendy Project and return to open session on the call of the chair and seconded by Councilmember Neal. The vote was unanimous.
- OPEN SESSION** Mayor McLean declared Council back in open session. Mayor Mclean stated that Council discussed one contractual matter and no action was taken.
- COUNCILMEMBER REPORT** Councilmember Jenkins stated that the ditches on West Centennial Street need to be cut. Councilmember Jenkins stated that a citizen has complained about leaves and old limbs on Davidson Street, Ferguson Street and Florida Street need to be picked up. Councilmember Jenkins stated that the pothole on the corner of Gary Street and D Street has been filled. Councilmember Jenkins stated that there is a dip in the road which needs to be addressed. Mr. Cannon, City Manager, stated that he would look into the matter.
- Councilmember Kuykendall stated that a house on the corner of Carolina Avenue and South Adair Street is becoming an issue because no one lives at the residence and the grass is high. Mr. Cannon stated that he would look into the matter. Councilmember Kuykendall stated that the downtown clock is not keeping time and needs to be fixed.
- ADJOURN** With there no further business before Council motion was made by Councilmember Cook to adjourn and seconded by Councilmember Neal. The vote was unanimous.
